

Analytics as the Claims Administrator for the above-captioned action (the “Action”).¹ I submit this affidavit as a supplement to my earlier affidavit, the Affidavit of Kari L. Schmidt Regarding Dissemination of Class Notice and Report on Requests for Exclusion Received (NYSCEF No. 141, the “Initial Mailing Affidavit”). I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein and, if called as a witness, could and would testify competently thereto.

MAILING OF THE NOTICE PACKET

2. Since the execution of my Initial Mailing Affidavit, Analytics has continued to disseminate copies of the Notice and Claim Form (the “Notice Packet”) in response to additional requests from potential Settlement Class Members and/or their nominees. Through the date of this affidavit, Analytics has mailed a total of 36,619 Notice Packets to potential Settlement Class Members and/or their nominees. Notice Packets have also been available for download on the case website (discussed below) and are not included in this total.

TELEPHONE HELPLINE AND WEBSITE

3. Analytics continues to maintain the toll-free telephone number (1-877-596-2204) and interactive voice response system to accommodate any inquiries from potential members of the Settlement Class. Analytics also continues to maintain the dedicated website for the Action (www.AlnylamSecuritiesLitigation.com) in order to assist Settlement Class Members. Analytics will continue to maintain and, as appropriate, update the website and toll-free telephone number until conclusion of the administration.

REPORT ON OBJECTIONS AND REQUESTS FOR EXCLUSION

4. The Notice informed potential Settlement Class Members that requests for exclusion were to be mailed to Analytics, postmarked no later than March 22, 2022. To date, Analytics has


received two (2) requests for exclusion, attached as Exhibit D to the Initial Mailing Affidavit (NYSCEF No. 145). Analytics has received no additional exclusion requests since the filing of the Initial Mailing Affidavit, dated March 7, 2022 (NYSCEF No. 141).



5. The Notice informed potential Settlement Class Members that objections to the proposed settlement were to be submitted to the Court, with copies sent to Plaintiff’s Counsel and Defendants’ Counsel, as to be received no later than March 22, 2022. Although not required to be sent to Analytics, in the course of our settlement administration work Analytics sometimes also receives copies of objections from class members. For the sake of completeness here, I note that as of the date of this affidavit, Analytics has received no objections.

NOTIFICATION OF VIDEO HEARING

6. Per the Preliminary Approval Order, the hearing scheduled for April 12, 2022 at 2:30 p.m. will be held via Microsoft Teams virtual platform. Analytics has updated the website for the Action to alert Settlement Class Members of the video and telephonic access information for the settlement hearing to ensure that potential Settlement Class Members can participate in the hearing if they so choose. A screenshot of the updated website is attached to this affidavit as Exhibit A.

The Court-appointed Lead Plaintiff, on behalf of itself and the Settlement Class, has reached a proposed settlement of this action, captioned *Chester County Employees Retirement Fund v Alynlam Pharmaceuticals, Inc., et al.*, Index No. 655272/2019 (N.Y.S.C) (the "Action"), for a cash payment of \$7,000,000 (the "Settlement"). The Settlement, if approved by the Court, will resolve all claims in this Action.

Your Rights in the Proposed Settlement

If you are a member of the Settlement Class, your rights will be affected and you may be eligible for a payment from the proceeds of the Settlement, if it receives final Court approval. The Class certified by the Court includes all persons or entities who purchased or otherwise acquired Alylam common stock between November 14, 2017 and September 12, 2019, inclusive, except those persons or entities that are excluded, as described below.

You are not a Settlement Class Member if you are: (a) Defendants and their immediate families; (b) the officers, directors and affiliates of Defendants during the Settlement Class Period and members of their immediate families; (c) the legal representatives, heirs, successors, or assigns of any of the foregoing; (d) and any entity in which any Defendant has or had a controlling interest. Also excluded from the Settlement Class is any person or entity who timely and validly requests exclusion from the Settlement Class as set forth in the Notice.

Please read the Notice to fully understand your rights and options. Copies of the Notice and Claim Form can be found in the menu at the top of this page.

If you are a member of the Settlement Class, in order to be potentially eligible to receive a payment from the Settlement, you must submit a Claim Form postmarked no later than **March 17, 2022**.

Payments to eligible claimants will be made only after the Settlement and a Plan of Allocation are approved by the Court and any appeals are resolved, and after the completion of all claims processing. Please be patient, as this process will take some time to complete.

MARCH 17, 2022	Claim Filing Deadline: Claim Forms must be <i>postmarked no later than</i> MARCH 17, 2022 to be eligible for a payment from the Settlement.
MARCH 22, 2022	Exclusion Deadline: If you do not want a payment from this Settlement, but you want to keep the right to sue or continue to sue any of the Defendants on your own about the same legal issues in this case, then you must take steps to get out of the Settlement Class. This is called excluding yourself or is sometimes referred to as opting out of the Settlement Class. Requests to be excluded from the proposed Settlement must be postmarked no later than MARCH 22, 2022 , in accordance with the instructions in the Notice.

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MARCH 22, 2022	Objection Deadline: Any objections to the proposed Settlement, the proposed Plan of Allocation, and/or Plaintiff's Counsel request for an award of attorneys' fees and expenses, must be received no later than MARCH 22, 2022 , in accordance with the instructions in the Notice.
APRIL 12, 2022 at 2:30 p.m.	<p>The Final Approval Hearing: A hearing will be held on APRIL 12, 2022 at 2:30 p.m. before the Honorable Robert R. Reed, at Part 43, via Microsoft Teams Virtual Platform. If there are objections, the Court will consider them and will listen to people who have asked to speak at the hearing. The Court may also decide how much should be awarded to Plaintiff's Counsel for attorneys' fees and expenses, and whether to approve a service award totaling no more than \$15,000 to the Plaintiff for its efforts in representing the Settlement Class.</p>
